REGULAR PROGRAMS

□ UNITED THROUGH READING

Record yourself reading and receive copies of the recording and book to share with your loved ones while you are apart.

□ READERS ARE LEADERS

■ 1.000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN

Ages 10-17 read monthly themed novels and enjoy activities engaging their creative skills. Copies of each month's book are provided. Registration required.

ADULT WRITING CLUB

Receive constructive feedback in an informal and supportive environment. All genres and creative writers are welcome. Registration required.

■ MAKER WORKSHOP

Gather to create, invent, and explore, using various Makerspace equipment and craft materials. Ages 10 and older. Registration required.

□ JUNIOR 3D CLUB

Allows tweens and younger teen patrons to enjoy beginner-level 3D printing demonstrations, collaborative projects, design challenges, and freestyle design time. Registration required.

□ 3D MODELING & PRINTING CLUB

Allows older teen and adult patrons to enjoy beginner-level 3D printing demonstrations, collaborative projects, design challenges, and freestyle design time. Registration required.

BORROWING POLICIES

Registration is open to active duty, DoD civilians, retirees, dependents, JMSDF, MLC, and IHA. Children 10 and older with a DoD ID may also register. Minors must present their ID and sign in at the front desk if visiting without a caregiver.

Once registered, items may be checked out using your DoD ID card. The borrowing period for all items is 3 weeks. Each account is allowed:

- Unlimited books and magazines
- ☐ Maximum of two video games & Launchpads
- ☐ One Makerbox (GoPro, needlepoint, tea ceremony, novelty cake pans, & Dash Robot)
- ☐ One DVD player or projector
- ☐ One Kindle
- ☐ Maximum of 10 each: music CDs/ audiobooks PlayAways/DVDs

RENEWALS

Patrons are allowed two renewals per item, each lasting three weeks. Items on hold and those borrowed through the Interlibrary Loan program cannot be renewed.

Renew items by calling the library or by accessing your account online.

HOLDS

May be placed on books and audio/visual items.

MINORS

Minors age 10 or older, must present their ID and sign in at the front desk if visiting without a caregiver.



View your checked out items, renew items, and place holds through the online catalog. If needed, you may contact the library for your login information. You must change your password upon logging in for the first time or library staff can reset it for you.



Scan to access the library's online catalog.

Access free digital resources such as Mango Languages, Continuing Education (Tutor.com), Children's Collection, Military Preperation Testing, eBooks and Audiobooks, Music, Videos,and Streaming Services(Kanopy), and much more.
