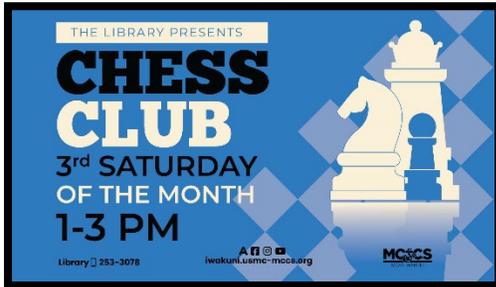


Japanese Author Book Club

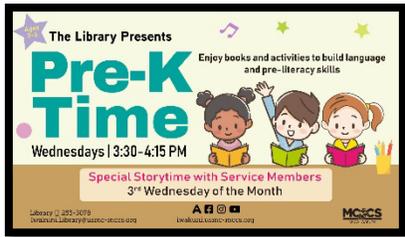

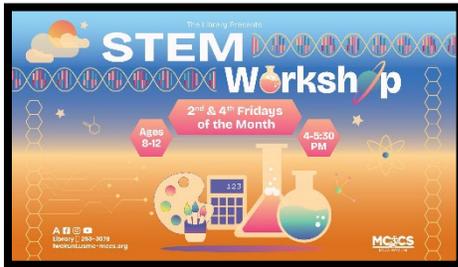

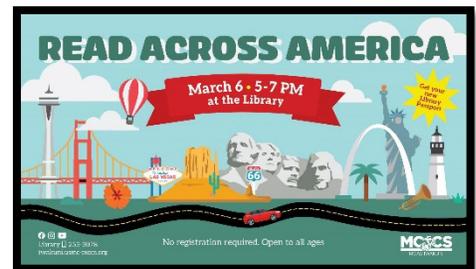
